## What is IGCSE?

If you're wondering what IGCSE stands for, here's the definition. International General Certificate of Secondary Education is abbreviated as IGCSE.

It is widely regarded and recognised as the most popular worldwide certification for the completion of secondary school and is similar to the British O-Level, UK GCSE, fifth form, or year 11.

Cambridge IGCSE offers examinations twice a year in June and November and results are out by August and January.
